## **Session Descriptions**

## Session 1: Assessing Your Organization: The Organizational Diagnostic Tool

Every organization has strengths and vulnerabilities, and many leaders are too close to the situation to see these clearly. In this session, we introduce a simple assessment tool that allows you to see how you rank on key indicators in three areas: Programs, People, and Money. This Organizational Diagnostic Tool can yield great benefits by helping to identify areas of need and then charting a course to a more robust strategy and better performance.

## Session 2: Taking the Mystery out of Financial Management

In this session, we will walk through the various components of financial management and true to its name, remove the mystery from financial management. We will focus on solid financial reporting and budgeting. Having a clear budget that is broken out by programs is a foundational element to an organization's financial sustainability. We will share a Program Based Budget template and instructions on how to use it.

## Session 3: Beyond Strategic Planning: Maximizing Your Impact as an Organization

In this session, we'll explore the range of planning and management approaches and tools that an organization should consider. We'll also explore the 'strategic mindset' that characterizes organizations that punch above their weight and look at how the board and staff can best work together to guide the organization's direction.

## Session 4: The Well-Managed Hiring Process: from Job Design to Onboarding



Bringing new people into the organization is a critical task leaders face. Assuring a fair and transparent process that yields the optimum candidate is a complex and demanding undertaking requiring effective tools and techniques. In this session, Katie will provide an overview of the hiring process with an emphasis on mitigating bias and conducting a thoughtful hiring and onboarding process.

# Session 5: Supervising with Confidence: Setting Clear Expectations and Establishing Mutual Accountability

We'd all like to spend less time addressing personnel issues and more time focusing on your work in the world. Learning how to create a foundation of clear expectations and mutual accountability is one of the most powerful and least frequently utilized practices that will set up supervisors and staff up for success. We'll also explore the impact of reducing assumptions and uncertainty, and share how simple, pragmatic tools like workplans and regular standardized check-ins and regular feedback to empower both supervisors and staff. This session will help staff teams operate with greater clarity, trust, and accountability.
